All dorms in Munich currently have internet access. Meals are not provided in the dorms, but there are student cafeterias on all 3 campuses where noon meals are served at very reasonable prices. |

In order to get a visa, you must apply for one at the embassy or consulate of the Federal Republic of Germany in your home country. You must apply for your visa at least 2 months ahead of time. Please do not travel to Germany on a tourist visa, since it cannot be changed |
